Gaudí's first house and a colorful mosaic of Moorish, oriental, and natural influences. A place where modernism took its first bold steps.

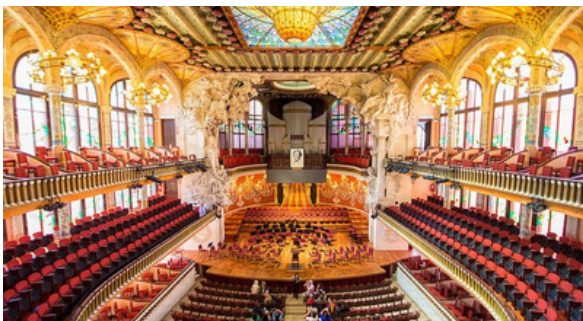


Sagrada Família
