Grand Bigard Castle

Just a short drive from Brussels, the enchanting Grand Bigard Castle offers a glimpse into Belgium's rich architectural and cultural heritage. Surrounded by a wide moat and centuries-old beech trees, this historic estate feels like stepping into a fairytale.

Visitors cross a five-arch bridge, flanked by 17thcentury heraldic lions, to reach the 15th-century drawbridge and fortified gate.



Inside, the right wing holds a chapel untouched for over 300 years, while the left is crowned with a distinctive bulb-shaped roof. Beside the entrance stands the imposing 14th-century Donjon tower, its rooftop terrace offering sweeping views of the Atomium and the Brussels skyline.

We would like to extend our sincere thanks to **Mr. Xavier Pelgrims**, the owner of Grand Bigard, for generously allowing us to host our dinner here and for kindly offering us a guided tour of his historic home.

Transport


The bus will also go back to the city centre at 23:00h, leaving you at the same meeting point.
